

REQUIRED TOOLS:


- Hydraulic Jack or Lift
- Metric Socket Set and Wrenches


INSTALLATION:

- 1) Raise vehicle and secure on lift or jack stands.
- 2) Using a hydraulic jack or screw jack, support the lower control arm.
- 3) Using an open-ended wrench and socket as shown, loosen and unbolt the inner side of the 'S' arm.
- 4) Loosen and unbolt the spindle side of the 'S' Arm.
- 5) Using the factory hardware, install the new 'S' Arm in reverse order.

NOTE: You may have to pry and/or raise or lower the spindle in order to get the bolts started.

- 6) Torque fasteners to **125ftlbs.**
- 7) Grease the poly bushing with a synthetic grease.





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
