

G-BODY DRIVESHAFT LOOP INSTALLATION Part # DSL003

Tools Required:

Jack 13mm wrench Jack Stands 11mm wrench

Installation:

- 1. Lift the vehicle and support with jack stands under the frame rails.
- **2.** Using the 11mm wrench, remove the driveshaft and tape the cups onto the u-joint to avoid needle bearing loss.
- **3.** Using the 13mm wrench, remove the OE chassis brace that is located just behind the transmission tail-shaft.
- **4.** Place the driveshaft loop into position where the OE brace was bolted with the loop facing upwards. Insert the bolts and tighten.
- 5. Reinstall the driveshaft and tighten the u-joint bolts.
- **6.** Lower vehicle.
