

## **Driveshaft Safety Loop Installation Instructions REQUIRED TOOLS:**

- Standard wrenches and sockets
- Hydraulic jack and Jack stands
- Drill

## **INSTALLATION:**

- 1. Lift vehicle and safely support with stands under the frame rails.
- 2. Disconnect and remove the exhaust where it goes under the driveshaft.
- 3. From inside the car, remove the front seats and pull the carpet back so the floorpan is exposed.
- 4. Use the bracket to mark out the locations in the floor and drill out the holes
- 5. Place the supplied nutplates on the top of the floor
- 6. Position the driveshaft safety loop under the car and use the supplied hardware to bolt it to the nutplates. Thread all of the bolts loosely before final torquing the bolts.
- 7. The carpet and front seats can now be reinstalled
- 8. Slide the safety loop around the driveshaft and place it on top of the bracket.
- 9. Reinstall the exhaust and lower the vehicle.
